Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me.I have made you[a] known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them."

Sermon

When I was 33 years old and my husband, Søren, was 32 - and our three children were 5, 3, and 0 - we were given the amazing opportunity to become the new leaders of *Farsø Efterskole*.

The school was to be established in the buildings that had previously housed Farsø Højskole. We were overjoyed - yes, almost blissful - in our youthful naivety.

The buildings needed a loving hand and we can say that Søren and I also needed loving hands - and we got them.

Cars rolled into the courtyard - several of them - and inside were members of the *Y's Men*, dressed in work clothes.

Loving hands - ready to make a difference.

They came to hang wallpaper, paint, clean, and pull weeds - not just for one day, but over many days.

At noon, we would sit down together and eat rye bread, liver pâté, and salami. We were happy - yes, nearly blissful.

Why did the Y's Men do it?

I believe there were several reasons.

Firstly, because they were - and are - equipped with loving hands and a mission greater that goes beyond themselves.

Then, I believe they sensed that the young school leaders needed help.

And finally, it seemed they truly enjoyed the work.

It was meaningful, it was helpful, and it was fun - in other words: fellowship at its best.

Fellowship is a central theme in today's service - and, I believe, of this entire conference.

Just before we, in fellowship, confessed our shared faith, we heard the words from Ecclesiastes:

"Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up."

Those are good words - for a good fellowship - because we need one another.

The Norwegian pastor *Per Arne Dahl* once said something that I often lean on:

"No one has arms long enough to wrap around themselves."

Per Arne Dahl opened his church in Oslo in the days following the terrible massacre at Utøya, where 68 young people lost their lives. Young people flocked to the church - and there, they embraced one another.

Because no one has arms long enough to wrap around themselves.

I know - it's quite a leap, going from founding Farsø Efterskole to the tragedy of Utøya - but life is full of such leaps. We know this - and we experience it all too often. From comfort and joy to fear and unrest.

Right now, we sit in one of the safest and most loving communities in the world - here in the Exhibition Centre - and we wish it could always be this way.

But outside, in the world, serious things are happening - we know this - and we know we cannot turn a blind eye.

The Gospel reading from John is part of Jesus' final prayer.

"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one..."

Jesus is saying farewell, and He does so with this prayer - this final prayer. A prayer that we all may be one - with one another, with Jesus, and thus with God.

Jesus' disciples - His friends - were probably thinking:

"Oh, can't we just stay here - in this fellowship - the safest, most loving fellowship in the world? Why must it end? Why can't Jesus just stay with us?"

The answer is: Because the mission of Jesus' life on Earth was precisely that the world's safest and most loving fellowship should never end.

Jesus prays for us:

"...I have made your name known to them, and will continue to make it known, so that the love you have for me may be in them, and I myself may be in them."

The other day I heard a lecture on new hymns by Bishop *Marianne Christiansen*. She shared that composers often begin writing a new hymn by studying the **final verse** closely - because it reveals the tone, the melody that fits the entire hymn.

The final verse - the final prayer in the story of Jesus - is about:

That you all may be one.

That is fellowship - that is the melody we must carry in faith, hope, and love - beyond all borders.

"...the love you have for me may be in them, and I myself may be in them."

We live in a dark and uncertain world - we feel it. Recently, I spoke with a woman from Myanmar. She told me how a school in her hometown was bombed while the children were in class. A terrible story.

I asked her: How do you keep your faith in a loving God?

She answered: We have only God's wings to crawl under - and under those wings, there is also space for our neighbour who is a Buddhist.

No one has arms long enough to wrap around themselves.

That's why we need all arms - and all loving hands.

Here in the Exhibition Center today, many of us have gray hair, and we may wonder—are our arms and hands still needed?

And the answer is - yes, absolutely!

Those who are 32 and 33 - and their children - need us. Not just for a helping hand now and then, but because they need us to uphold **hope**, **courage**, **and joy**.

They need us to keep the church open - with the message that the final verse is bright and good - and therefore the melody must be, too.

When we celebrate worship, we don't do it just for ourselves - we do it for our children and grandchildren.

And when we put on our work clothes, we do so with joy - rejoicing in the fellowship under God's wings and in the space of Jesus' prayer for us.

It may sound naïve - and it is - but it is also Christian: simple and difficult at once.

And true it is - as written in Ecclesiastes:

"But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up. Also, if two lie down together, they will keep warm. But how can one keep warm alone? Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves."

Amen.

Let us all pray:

God, give hope to the hopeless!

Make all who hope in You messengers of hope.

Let a human gaze shine upon those who have lost hope.

Make us joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Amen.

Regional management and Regional service Directors report 2024-25

The big words from the international strategic plan 'Strategy 2032': 'Eminence in Fellowship and Community Impact' were already put into action at the Lunderskov meeting in 2024. It is therefore natural that 'community' became a central part of the work of the Regional Management Team, but let's take a walk through the year 2024-25 together - a year filled with new people, strong communities and important developments throughout our movement.

The expansion of the leadership from 4 to 7 members is in itself a larger community, and as the secretariat also has expanded by one person, the leadership community is now 11 participants. This requires a changed form of management meetings, where all members have a real opportunity to influence decisions as well as development and initiatives.

A large management team also means many ideas and key issues, so selection and priority needed. All ideas, key issues and dreams were posted, explained and debated - 109 in total - which formed the basis for internal working groups in Management and Secretariat.

Regional Service Directors

We have a continued need for service managers (RSD) - but in a smaller scale, partly because two former service managers (RSD) now were part of the Regional Management Team. The contact with the YMCA and YMCA is crucial, and it was natural to ask Nis Thaysen, Alssund Y's Men's Club, to continue. He says: 'It's been an exciting year to participate in the executive board of the YMCA and YMCA. A new vision has been adopted, which reads: 'Children and young people should have reason to believe, have hope for tomorrow and know that they are needed today.' Developing a new vision has been a good process. A new Secretary General, Gritt Rhinstrøm, has also been appointed. The current Secretary General, Jørgen Kvist, has chosen to concentrate on his political work. Gritt has been project manager for Fairhuset.'

Region Denmark support the establishment of two new Fairhouses in Copenhagen and Esbjerg as a regional project in 2025-26.

VAT compensation

The task of calculating the VAT compensation that the region and the clubs will be entitled to requires professional insight and accuracy. Hans Nørgaard Wedel, Sct. Jørgens Y's Men's Club, Holstebro, has done this work in an impressive manner, raising significant amounts of money for the benefit of the movement. He reports: 'Material for applying for a VAT refund has been sent directly to the presidium of the clubs. It is also posted on the Region's website. In 2024, we have been reimbursed DKK 363,450, which means that we have been reimbursed just over 30% of the amount we applied for. The amount is at the same level as in 2023.

The amount has been distributed among the almost 70 clubs that applied, so there is room for more.

In order for us to retain our status as a charitable organisation, it is important that you as a private individual contribute at least DKK 200 to our tax-deductible projects.

It is equally important that you provide your social security number so that your donation can be registered with the tax authorities. In addition to supporting a good cause, you are also supporting our own organisation.

We are still working on how we should relate to the requirements of the Danish Bookkeeping Act regarding digital storage of receipts. ISOBRO has yet to get back to us on how we should proceed.'

International funds and programmes

The administration of international funds and programmes has to be solvedby a person who have experience and insight into practices and customs. Torben Kristensen, Viborg Y's Men's Club, agreed to continue this task, and he writes: 'ASF Foundation: There have been more activities in the past Y's Men's year, but with fewer payments.

Typically, courses and leadership training are organised for several at a time. Therefore, it is not the individual who applies. There is no doubt that the support is needed. There is a great deal of gratitude from those who receive support. So remember the ASF Foundation when you give out grants. 70% of the funding stays in Denmark.

The YES Foundation: We are in a time when funds are really needed for the development of Y's Men in Eastern Europe. We have the strength and the means for this work. To help train leaders. To help them develop the work.

The Endowment Fund and the Golden Book: There have been a couple of requests for inclusion in the Golden Book. The funds raised in this connection go to extension. Support funds are also needed here.'

This year, the YES Foundation has supported two projects in Region Denmark with a total of DKK 137,500.

Follow-up to the conference in Roskilde

After the general assembly in Roskilde, the regional management team followed up on decisions and events. The big decision to have a seven-person Regional Board with a two-year rotation period was the reason to many good discussions and the creation of various job descriptions and terms of reference. It is important that everyone in the Management Team takes responsibility and feels valued. The different competences that each member was able to bring to the table greatly strengthened the management team's capabilities.

One of the events at the conference that left its mark on the management was a small CEE Seminar for participants from the Central and Eastern European clubs. The seminar reflected a great commitment and a desire to have a say in the development of clubs and districts etc. in the area, but with a continued affiliation and integration in Region Denmark. This became one of the major challenges for the regional management this year.

CEE area

Our CEE committee, headed by RSD Henrik Jeppesen, had for a long time articulated that CEE clubs and districts could work together as one section. Many of the joint meetings reflected this model, and this was particularly evident during the Vienna meeting in mid-November 2024. Once a year, the district leaders from the CEE area gather in Vienna with representatives from the CEE committee to discuss various matters and develop the community and the Y's Men's movement. This time the meeting was organised, managed and run mainly by CEE members, and it gave the Regional Management Committee the opportunity to intensify its consideration of formalising a CEE structure. It was a tremendous collaboration with leaders from CEE clubs, which - after many different discussions and proposals - resulted in the Regional Management, with the full support of the Regional Council, can present the General Assembly with a 'total CEE Section package' for approval.

New and old clubs

As far back as the eye can see, work has been done to establish new clubs, and various committees have been set up to fulfil this task. RLM Jørgen Sandgaard was a member of the previous committee, so it was natural for him to establish a working group to continue this important work. At the same time, there was a greater focus on retaining current members. The acronym EMC covers both development and conservation. Over the years, our older members have made a huge effort to spread the Y's Men's movement and worked for non-profit and charitable work. They deserve a lot of recognition for this - and we would like them to 'stay a little longer'.

There were no new Danish clubs in this Y's Men's year. RDE Kristian Helms chartered a new club in Tirana, Albania in October 2024. It was a great experience that brought back memories of RD Knud Erik Lykke, who started the work about 15 years ago. Knud Erik Lykke was remembered and honoured at the charter in Tirana.

The average age of Danish Y's Men is on the high end, but the loyalty to Y's Men is unwavering. Of course, we are seeing a loss of older members,

but there is reason to congratulate and welcome 109 new Y's Men's members in the past year.

The region's economy

Our treasurer for several years, RT Hardi Kristensen, has regularly provided the management with current figures on the financial situation. Money has been claimed from the funds and schemes from which we can receive support, and our obligations to the head office in Geneva and Area Europe have been settled. As you can see from the annual report, the change in staffing of management and service directors has resulted in displacements. The result allowed the purchase of a new photocopier, as the hard disc and other items in the old one could no longer be repaired.

Connecting with clubs and members

It has been important for Management to provide clubs and members with knowledge about what Management is doing. A communication committee was established, which is chaired by RLM Jette Jepsen. It has been a busy year for the committee, which includes RSF Axel F. A. Hansen, with the continued roll-out of last year's branding material, new layouts for leaflets and brochures and other good ideas for marketing and PR. The two most demanding tasks are probably the publication of the many newsletters and the extensive material etc. for 'Himmelske Dage - Churches' People's Summit' in Silkeborg on 29 May - 1 June 2025.

Through the members of the Regional Council, the Management has received and provided information that could be of importance to clubs and members, and RDEE Søren Winther Nielsen has been editor of an inspiration catalogue, which can be seen as a replacement for the previous scheme, 'Book an R' '.

Relationships with Y's Men International

In 2024-25, Region Denmark made a decisive impact on our international movement.

Our long-time member, Erik Breum, Sønderborg Y's Men's Club, passed away. We honour his memory. In Denmark. He was a welcome chairman

at general meetings year after year. Internationally, he was International Treasurer (IT) several times, and he has been Area Treasurer (AT) for several terms. The list of Erik's positions of trust in Y's Men is long and impressive.

When a vacancy arose in the top international position (IP), a by-election of an IPE was needed. Region Denmark played a crucial role in the nomination and election of RD Johan Vilhelm Eltvik, Norway. At the time of writing, the election of a new International Treasurer (IT) - Erik Breum's successor - is running. We expect that Region Denmark will be the most important Region with the election of Svend Erik Nielsen, Hedens Y's Men's Club.

The Area Council consists of the four RDEs (Norway, Finland/Baltic, Central/Southern Europe and Denmark), and the traditional two meetings have been held I Gjøvik, Norge.

The annual RDE-Summit - a seminar for future regional leaders - has also been held. This time it was in India, where RDE Kristian Helms participated. Region Denmark's recognition among other future regional leaders is overwhelming. It is great - but a challenge - to be the world's largest Y's Men's region, and there are calls from IHQ and Area Council to expand with Armenia and Ukraine.

The regional management recommends the creation of a new section for the CEE region and the following legislative changes:

The energetic efforts and passion of the CEE Committee and previously dedicated Y's Men for the expansion of the Y's Men movement in the countries of Central/Eastern Europe has recently developed to such an extent that the Regional Management sees a need to strengthen this development further by enabling greater personal ownership for Y's Men members in the CEE area. Many Y's Men in the CEE area are taking on greater and greater involvement and responsibility in the co-operation with the CEE Committee, which is why a Section under Region Denmark is considered a possibility.

Re. 7. a. 1:

Established a Section - integrated in Region Denmark - comprising current and future chartered Y's Men's clubs and districts in the CEE area. The section will be placed on the same level as the districts.

Re. 7. a. 2:

The creation of a CEE Section requires the approval of the following legislative changes.

Proposal to amend the § 14, stk. 1:

Current wording:

The Regional Council consists of the Regional Management and one member from each district management (DG, DGE or DGEE). One or more district managements may choose to be represented by another district or a specially appointed person. (VR 406-408).

Proposal for new wording:

The Regional Council consists of the Regional Management and one member from each district management (DG, DGE or DGEE), resident in Denmark, and one member from 'CEE-Section- Management'. The latter's vote is weighted according to the current number of districts in the Section (currently 6 votes). Other members have one vote each.

The district management and section management may choose to be represented by another district or a specially appointed person. (VR 406-408).

The District Leaders elect one member from among their number to sit on the Regional Council. Geographical or other circumstances may dictate that a district may find it appropriate to authorise another district or a specific person - e.g. a parent club member or a country coordinator - to be represented at Regional Council meetings. In this case, the authorised district or person is obliged to keep the district in question informed of all important matters and decisions. In the event that the members of the district leadership cannot agree on the election of a Regional Councillor, the District Governor (DG) shall have the seat on the Regional Council.

Proposal for new wording:

The District Managements and Section Managements shall elect one member from among themselves to sit on the Regional Council. The election is valid for one club year at a time, except in the case of legal incapacity, but re-election may take place. For example, a DGE can sit on the Regional Council for 2 consecutive years (as DGE and as DG). A DGEE can be on the Regional Council for 3 years if the District Management feels that this provides greater continuity.

In the event that the District Management/CEE Management members cannot agree on the election of a Regional Councillor, the District Manager (DG)/ CEE CEE Manager shall have the seat on the Regional Council.

Proposal for a new § 17 a (CEE Section):

§ 17a

Current and future chartered Y's Mens clubs in the CEE area are gathered in a 'CEE Section', with partial powers of its own, but still as an integrated part of YMI Region Denmark.

The 'Statute for the CEE Section' lays down rules for the Section's activities. These rules must be approved by Region Denmark according to the same rules as legislative changes.

The term of office for CEE Section leaders is 2 years.

Recommendation for approval of the Statutes for the CEE Section:

The Y's Men International International Association of Y's Men's Clubs

The Association is a worldwide fellowship of persons of all faiths working together in mutual respect and affection, based on the teachings of Jesus Christ, and with a common loyalty to the Young Men's Christian Association, striving through active service to develop, encourage and provide leadership to build a better world for all. The movement is divided into independent regions, which have adopted their own laws within the overall international mission statement.

Preamble

In order to strengthen the cohesion between the clubs in Central/Eastern Europe and build the community that is the hallmark of the Y's Men movement, these clubs are

brought together in a Section with certain independent powers - but still as an integral part of Y's Men International Region Denmark.

Statute

for

CEE Section of Y's Men International Region Denmark

§1 Name

The name of the section is "CEE Section of Y's Men International Region Denmark". Instead of the full official name, the abbreviation "CEE Section" may be used.

§2 Establishment and foundation

"CEE Section" is established by special resolution at Region Denmark's general meeting on June 21, 2025 in Aars.

§3 Purpose and tasks

The purpose of establishing the CEE Section is to future-proof the development of the Y's Men movement in the CEE countries by introducing a step-by-step process that can lead to the creation of an independent region.

The establishment of the CEE Section with delegated powers is the first step in building these changes. Its purpose is to maintain and deepen the cooperation that already exists between the countries.

The role of the CEE Section is to coordinate the activities of the affiliated Y's Men clubs in the CEE countries with the help of the CEE country leaders. To utilize the potential of club members to learn about each other's history, culture and way of life, to inspire each other for club and membership development and thus better promote common interests.

The role of the CEE Section is to carry out the purposes of the movement on a Christian basis, within its territory and according to regional and international law, and to participate actively in the tasks delegated to it from the regional level.

§ 4 Competencies.

The "CEE Section" is an integral part of the organizational structure of YMI Region Denmark - on the same level as Danish districts - and is subject to decisions made by Region Denmark's General Assembly, Regional Council and Regional Management.

The laws and statutes of Region Denmark also apply to the "CEE Section" unless these statutes prescribe otherwise.

The "CEE Section" reports to Region Denmark's Regional Management, represented by the Regional Director (RD) or the management member who may be appointed as responsible for the CEE area.

§ 5 Member of the CEE Section.

"CEE Section" consists of the affiliated Y's Men clubs chartered under Region Denmark and based in Central and Eastern Europe, as defined from time to time by the laws of Region Denmark, but currently includes: Poland, Hungary, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Romania, Moldova, Kosovo and Albania.

§ 6 Organization of the "CEE Section":

- The CEE Section is headed by the CEE Section Management.
- The "CEE Section" is composed from "Districts", each comprising a number of clubs within a defined geographical area.
- The "CEE Section" members are all Y's Mens clubs in the "CEE Section" area.

§ 7 "CEE Section Management".

"CEE Section" is led by 'CEE Section Management', consisting of the Section Leader and two members.

Members for the CEE Section's first management are appointed by Region Denmark's General Assembly on June 21, 2025.

Every second year in even numbered years - the first time in 2028 - a CEE Section Manager is elected at the annual CEE Section meeting, and every second year in odd numbered years - the first time in 2027 - two CEE Section members are elected.

The term of office for the CEE Section management members is 2 years.

The CEE Section Leader is considered the CEE Section's highest administrative leader and represents the CEE Section in all matters within the CEE Section. The section leader is responsible to Region Denmark's management for the CEE Section's finances, administration and coordination.

The CEE Section Management determines its own rules of procedure, containing the internal distribution of tasks, responsibilities and competencies among the CEE Section management members. The rules of procedure must be approved by the Regional Council.

Together with the CEE Section's other employees, the Section Management must seek to inspire the Section's clubs to develop club work in accordance with the movement's purpose and traditions for the benefit of the local communities.

The tasks of "CEE-Section-Management" include

- a) coordinate membership registration and collection of membership fees,
- b) determine the Section's own finances (budget) and set membership fees accordingly,
- c) in consultation with the "CEE Committee" to allocate funds made available from the "Region Denmark Extension Support Fund" according to the fund's approved budget for the CEE area.
- d) manage funds and grants responsibly,
- e) coordination of project activities,
- f) developing relationships, training/education,
- g) expansion and fundraising
- h) other tasks that are a natural part of the development of the CEE region.

§ 8 CEE Section Service Directors.

In order to perform the tasks incumbent on the "CEE Section", the CEE Section Management may appoint a number of Service Directors to perform specified tasks or functions in close cooperation with the Section Management.

At the establishment of the CEE Section, Service Directors (SSD) are appointed for the following tasks:

- a) SSD for finance
- b) SSD for CEE projects
- c) SSD for training/education
- d) SSD for expansion and fundraising
- e) SSD for liaison with YMCA

For each position, the "CEE Section Management" shall draw up a job description.

§ 9 CEE Section "Districts".

The section is divided into districts.

A district is a defined - as far as possible contiguous - geographical area and should include at least 3 clubs.

Districts are the link between CEE Section Management and the clubs.

The number of districts can be changed with the approval of the Regional Council.

Each district is led by a district management consisting of a District Governor, District Governor Elect and District Governor Elect Elect.

Every two years, clubs in the district elect a District Governor Elect Elect (DGEE) who joins the district leadership at the beginning of the Y's Mens year. The following year they move up to District Governor Elect (DGE) and after another year to District Governor (DG), who is considered the district's top administrative leader.

The District Leaders' functions and tasks will include

- working with Section Service Directors (SSD) and Club Presidents,
- verify that the club membership list is complete,
- sending an updated list of club members to the SSD, to the regional database administrator and a copy to the Section Leader,
- administer the payment of membership fees to the CEE Section bank account,
- resolve together with SSD any problems regarding the database and membership transfer,
- inform about submitted CEE projects, their implementation and accounting
- cooperate with SSDs and club presidents in the field of education,
- translate or organize the translation of training materials into the local language,
- organize district-level training and coordinate club-level training,
- use district conferences to educate club members,
- work with SSD to provide data on local conditions in extension and fundraising.

CEE Section Management may modify or increase the duties of district leadership on an ongoing basis and describe these in a District Manual.

§ 10 CEE Section "Clubs".

The members of the section are the Y's Men's clubs that are chartered with the International Association of Y's Men's Clubs and registered in Y's Men Region Denmark.

Each club is led by a presidium of at least 4 members, who can be called president, vice president, treasurer and secretary.

The club may choose to use other designations for the presidium members.

The affiliated Y's Men's clubs shall further the purposes of the movement by:

- Functioning primarily as service clubs of the YMCA and YWCA,
- Supporting other valuable organizational work,

- Providing practical as well as financial support for general charitable purposes, including non-profit, church, humanitarian, relief and development projects,
- To encourage fairness in social and international issues, the clubs always refraining from partisan politics,
- To keep members informed and actively involved in religious, civic, economic, social and international affairs,
- that the club refrain from taking partisan political positions and that individual members refrain from using the club for political agitation,
- To cultivate good fellowship,
- to support international, area and regional projects of the movement.

The duties of the affiliated clubs are:

- to meet regularly for meal fellowships or similar,
- to ensure regular attendance,
- to conduct regular club activity in furtherance of the purpose of the club,
- to respond to CEE Section Management's direct requests in a timely or reasonable manner,
- to pay agreed dues to the CEE Section and the Region in proportion to the club's membership in a timely manner.

§ 11 General principles and working conditions in the CEE Section

In general, the following principles apply to working in the CEE section:

- democratic principles are applied,
- the common language of the CEE Section is English,
- districts may use their respective national languages,
- the term of office for CEE Section positions is at least two years for all CEE Section stakeholders (districts, CDGs, clubs) and leaders from Region Denmark,
- Region Denmark is regularly informed about the change process.

§ 12 Requirements for candidates for work in the CEE Section

General requirements for candidates for positions in the CEE section:

The candidate:

• identifies with the values of the Y's Men movement and has previous experience of active work for the Y's Men movement,

- agrees with the goal of the development concept of the CEE Y's Men movement and will fulfill the position as a volunteer,
- has the trust of the district team and the Danish leaders.
- in the early stages of the work are nominated by the Danish leaders, in later periods they are filled by election,
- is expected to accept the nomination,
- will be part of an organization where normally all countries that are part of the CEE section are represented.

§ 13 Financial management

The financial management of the CEE Section is part of the YMI Region Denmark accounts.

The CEE Section's income and expenses are analytically recorded in the regional accounts.

The CEE Section has a bank account under the regional main account. The SSD for Finance has access to and insight into this account. CEE Section Management agrees with the YMI treasurer how the CEE Section's bookkeeping and sub-accounts are to be organized and which tasks are to be carried out by the CEE Section's SSD for Finance.

All positions in the CEE Section are unpaid. Direct expenses may be reimbursed.

The CEE Section has no statutory representative and no authority to sign commitments. It is represented at meetings by the Section Leader (Chair) or a delegated member of the CEE Section Management.

§ 14 Closing provisions


The CEE Section may be dissolved if the purpose for which it was established has not been fulfilled or if it does not perform the tasks delegated to it. The final decision shall be made by the General Assembly of YMI Region Denmark.

These statutes shall enter into force on July 1, 2025.

Amendments and additions to these statutes shall be approved upon proposal from "CEE Section Management" by the Regional Council of YMI Region Denmark, which shall decide whether the amendments are of such content that they must be approved by the General Assembly of YMI Region Denmark.

Then Pope Francis said to Henrik Stubkjær: 'But remember, my good friend – it is in times of change that the Holy Spirit has the opportunity to rearrange things'.

The Holy Spirit blows – without us being able to see it – enabling us to work for joy and benefit – and release energy – not by our own power, but by God's.

Just as the breath of life was breathed into Adam, so too is life breathed into us every day.

The world is changing – the Holy Spirit rearranges, and when we wake up again tomorrow, it is to live.

The little child who comes into the world must breathe. If it does not do so on its own, it gets a little slap on the back – for it must live – and so must we.

May the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all -

and may the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ fill us tonight

and may God's love live in us tomorrow – and the days to come.
